About the DZL

The German Center for Lung Research (DZL) was founded in 2011 and is one of the eight German Centers for Health Research (DZG), funded by the Federal Ministry of Research, Technology, and Space (BMFTR). At five locations across Germany, the DZL brings together 28 leading university and non-university research institutions in the field of lung research. Around 300 scientists work with their teams on the shared mission of “translational research to combat widespread lung diseases”, aiming to rapidly develop new approaches for prevention, diagnosis, and therapy and translate them into clinical practice.

The research focuses on eight disease areas:

- Asthma & Allergies
- Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease
- Cystic Fibrosis & Bronchiectasis
- Pneumonia & Acute Lung Injury
- Diffuse Parenchymal Lung Diseases
- Pulmonary Hypertension
